The establishment of the Chair is expected to:

Duration:

The appointment of the Chair will be made for a maximum of 3 terms of four months each per year during three consecutive years.

- Salary of Rs. 2.25 lakhs per month
- Travel of Rs. 1.0 lakh
- Research Grant of Rs. 2. 0 lakhs
- Contingency of Rs. 1. 5 lakhs
