Flavia Agnes is an eminent women's rights activist and legal scholar. She is a pioneer of the women's movement in India and is well-known for her work on legal reforms. She is the co-founder of Majlis, a legal and cultural resource centre that provides services to the victims of domestic and sexual violence in Mumbai. Majlis also conducts judicial training to create legal awareness about the Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act (2005) and the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act (2012). Among the numerous publications of Ms. Agnes are her autobiographical book, "My Story Our Story ... Of Rebuilding Broken Lives"; "Law & Gender Inequality – the Politics of Personal Laws in India"; "State, Gender and the Rhetoric of Law Reform"; "Family Laws" (two volumes) and an omnibus titled "Women and Law in India".
